

**KINGS COUNTY, CALIF.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along State Route (SR) 43, between Pickerell and Oregon avenues in Kings County for road work. Work is scheduled from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. starting Thursday, Oct. 31 through Thursday, Nov. 14, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

**Work is scheduled from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. starting Thursday, Oct. 31 through Thursday, Nov. 14, 2024.**

**TULARE COUNTY, CALIF.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent closures along Poplar Avenue between 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and State Route 43 in Tulare County for ongoing work at the Tule River Viaduct. Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. beginning Thursday November 7<sup>th</sup> through Thursday November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

## California State Parks Invites Military Community to Enjoy Free Access to 144 Parks on Veterans Day

**SACRAMENTO** – To show appreciation for the service of U.S. military members, California State Parks is offering free admission to 144 select state parks on Veterans Day, Monday, Nov. 11, 2024.

“California State Parks deeply values the sacrifices made by members of our nation’s military and their families,” said California State Parks Director Armando Quintero. “Offering free admission to our beautiful state parks is a small but meaningful way we say ‘thank you’ for their invaluable service. We hope our parks will serve as great spaces to find peace, reflection and connection for our nation’s heroes and their families.”

Signed by Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr. in 2013, [Assembly Bill 150 \(Olsen\)](#), authorized California State Parks to offer veterans, active duty and reserve military personnel from the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard and the National Guard of any state a reduced fee or free day use at participating state parks.

A variety of parks throughout California will offer free access. Historic state parks include [Marshall Gold Discovery](#), [Petaluma Adobe](#) and [El Presidio de Santa Barbara](#). State beaches include [Torrey Pines](#), [Pismo](#) and [Pescadero](#). State vehicular recreation areas include [Hollister Hills](#), [Eastern Kern County Onyx Ranch](#) and [Prairie City](#).

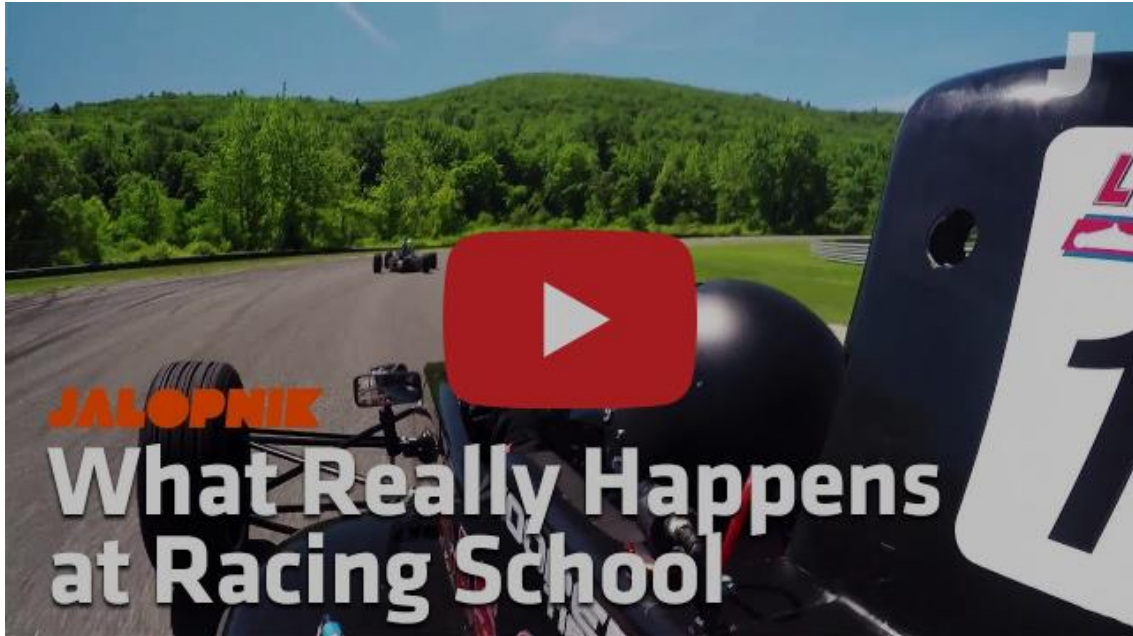


