COUNTY SUPERVISOR

2nd Supervisorial District

Jurisdiction - County
Term – 4 Years
Begins – January 6, 2021

Qualifications – A U.S. citizen, registered voter of the district which the candidate seeks to represent for at least 30 days preceding the deadline for filing nomination documents for the office. Must reside in the district during incumbency. (Gov. Code 24001, 24200, 25014)

Jurisdiction - County
Term – 4 Years
Begins – January 6, 2021

SUPERIOR COURT JUDGE

Incumbents – Michael J. Reinhart, Randy Edwards, Valerie R. Chrissakis
Jurisdiction - State
Term – 6 Years
Begins – January 6, 2021

Qualifications – A U.S. citizen, registered voter of the state, member of the State Bar for 10 years or have served as a judge of a California court of record immediately preceding the election. (Elec. Code 13, 13.5, CA Const, Art VI, 15 & 16)

DEMOCRATIC CENTRAL COMMITTEE

Incumbents –
Jurisdiction - County
Term – 4 Years
Begins – January 6, 2021

Qualifications – A U.S. citizen, registered voter of the state, A person shall not be eligible for appointment or election to a committee who is not registered as affiliated with this party at the time of his or her appointment or election. (Elec. Code 7209)

REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE

Incumbents –
Jurisdiction - County
Term – 4 Years
Begins – January 6, 2021

Qualifications – A U.S. citizen, registered voter of the state, A person shall not be eligible for appointment or election to a committee who is not registered as affiliated with this party at the time of his or her appointment or election. (Elec. Code 7407)
