## Position Description

### 00102199 - FOOD SERVICE WORKER II (SAFETY)

Supervises the serving and portion control of food in a large dining room in a State developmental center, hospital, or correctional facility contracting with the Department of Mental Health for diagnostic and treatment services; assigns posts to dining room employees and helpers from the resident population, which includes developmentally or mentally disordered offenders, and trains and instructs them in serving methods and sanitation standards; supervises and assists with table setting, dining room preparation for meal service, cleaning of tables after meals, and maintenance and arrangement of a dining and serving area, equipment, and utensils; maintains uniform food-handling practices and standards of safety and sanitation in an assigned dining room; observes and reports on residents' attitudes toward foods served; keeps food acceptance and plate-wastage records; supervises the cleaning of cooking pots and equipment in a central pot-washing room at a State developmental center, hospital, or correctional facility contracting with the Department of Mental Health for diagnostic and treatment services; operates and maintains pot-washing machinery; supervises the preparation of fruits and vegetables for cooking in a central vegetable room at a State developmental center, hospital or correctional facility contracting with the Department of Mental Health for diagnostic and treatment services and operates and maintains machinery used in the preparation of fruits and vegetables; supervises clean-up operations in the bake shop and such other duties as bread slicing, weighing ingredients, and allocation and distribution of bakery items to the wards; evaluates the performance of employees and helpers from the resident population, which includes developmentally or mentally disordered offenders and recommends appropriate action; orders, receives and supervises storage and inventory of supplies; keeps records and makes reports; and observes and intervenes in instances of disruptive or assaultive behavior.

Assists staff in the counting, distribution, and accounting for all utensils to prevent their use as weapons; inspecting facility to identify security breaches that could lead to forensic client, patient, or inmate escape; and observing and intervening in forensic client, patient, or inmate behavior that may signal an impending escape attempt.

Special Personal Characteristics: Willingness to work at developmental center, State hospitals, or correctional facilities contracting with the Department of Mental Health for diagnostic and treatment services; sympathetic and objective understanding of the problems of developmentally or mentally disordered offenders and the willingness to work with; personal cleanliness; good sense of smell and taste; freedom from communicable diseases; tact; patience; and emotional stability.

**High School Equivalence:** Equivalence to completion of the 12th grade may be demonstrated in any one of the following ways: 1) passing the General Education Development (GED) Test; 2) completion of 12 semester units of college-level work; 3) certification from the State Department of Education, a local school board, or high school authorities that the competitor is considered to have education equivalent to graduation from high school; or 4) for clerical and accounting classes, substitution of business college work in place of high school on a year-for-year basis.

Accepted applicants must provide proof of identification at each in-person test session. Acceptable identification consists of a photo identification card or two forms of signed identification.
