Emergency Child Care for Essential Workers & At-Risk Populations

Emergency subsidized child care services are now available for Essential Workers and At-Risk children and families. Services are temporary and can only be provided until June 30, 2020 or until the State of Emergency has ended, whichever occurs first.

Who is eligible?

Essential Sector

- Healthcare/Public Health or Emergency Service
- Food/Agriculture, Energy, Water/Wastewater, Transportation/Logistics, Communications/IT, Community-based Government Operations/Essential Functions, Critical Manufacturing, Hazardous, Financial, Chemical, Defense Industrial Base, or Staff/Providers of Child Care and Education Services

At Risk Populations

- Child Protective Services
- Emergency Child Care Foster Bridge
- Homelessness
- Children of Domestic Violence Survivor

1. A phone screening will be conducted to determine eligibility and priority.
2. A phone appointment with a KCAO Child Care Enrollment Specialist will be scheduled in order to complete an application for temporary child care services.

Limited funding is available and child care services are not guaranteed.

Child care slots will be allocated in priority order as directed by the California Department of Education
