

Bermuda grass

Description:

Bermuda grass is a common weed found in Kings County and can be found in gardens, landscapes, turf areas, orchards, roadsides, vineyards, and industrial areas. It is a perennial grass that is frequently used for lawns but also is a troublesome weed in many gardens. The plant grows rapidly when temperatures are warm and moisture is abundant. The mature plant forms dense mats with spreading and branching stolons that root at the nodes. The flowering spikes of Bermuda grass radiate from a single point at the tip of the stem. The collar region of Bermuda grass has a fringe of short, white hairs.
