#### **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Conduct a hearing to consider the Assessor's Request for Clarification of the Board's Decision on Application Nos. 15-013 through 15-017, 15-036, and 16-012 through 16-016.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Following hearings on the above applications held on July 29, 2019 and September 23, 2019, the Board unanimously voted to: 1) accept the stipulation of the parties as to the Applicant's real property as reached in October 2017 for the applications filed in 2015 and 2016; 2) deny the Assessor's request for a higher value for certain assets that were the subject of the raise letter; 3) and deny the Applicant's appeal seeking a reduction in assessed value of personal property and fixtures. The Assessor seeks clarification of the Board's decision, to which Applicant objects. This hearing is to consider the merits of the parties' arguments for and against the Assessor's Request for Clarification and render a decision.
