Gentlemen.

In compliance with Section 65.5 of the Agricultural Code, I hereby submit the Annual Kings County Crop Report, giving production and gross value of all crops produced in 1958.

The rainfall for 1958 of 13.5 inches was not the all time high but was so continuous during the winter and spring it had an adverse effect on some crops. The barley crop was disappointing in quanity and quality. Cotton got off to a late start, much of the acreage being planted in May, but the fall weather was so favorable that the crop averaged only ten pounds lighter than the 1957 record crop.

We are including permanent pasture this year the first time for a number of years. This is becoming a major crop of vital importance to the dairy and livestock industries of the county.

We wish to express our appreciation to all who furnished information to us which was used in the compiliation of this report.
