206.9 REQUIRED COURSE OF FIRE

For NEW LICENSE applicants, the course of training for issuance of a CCW license shall be no less than 8 hours, but shall not exceeded 16 hours in length.

- (a) The course shall include instruction of firearm safety, firearm handling, shooting technique and laws regarding the permissible use of a firearm.
- (b) The course shall include live-fire shooting exercises on the firing range and shall include a demonstration by the applicant of safe handling of and shooting proficiency with each firearm.
- (c) The course of fire shall consist of firing the maximum amount of rounds in each magazine or cylinder (not including one in the chamber) from 7 yards. The minimum pass score for qualification will be 50% within center mass. After successful completion of this initial course of fire, each additional firearm to be listed on the CCW license shall consist of firing the maximum amount of rounds in each magazine or cylinder (not including one in the chamber) from 7 yards. A passing score of 50% within center mass will apply for this as well.
- (d) Instructors, please have the minimum requirements noted on the applicant's certificate.

For LICENSE RENEWAL applicants, the courses of training for issuance of a CCW license shall be no less than 4 hours AND include sections a, b and c listed above.
