Private Applicator

A private applicator certificate is required for anyone applying for a restricted materials pesticide permit, intends to apply pesticides themselves and doesn't hold a QAL or QAC.

Qualified Applicator

A person that is licensed under the California Qualified Applicator Licensing program, such as QAL or QAC.

- Private Applicator Certificate holders shall complete continuing education requirements during the time the certificate is valid, or retake and pass the examination.
- A minimum of 2 hours in Laws are required. Certificates valid from 12-24 months at time of renewal shall have completed 4 hours of CE. Certificates valid from 24-36 months at time of renewal shall have completed 6 hours of CE.

If your last name begins with "A" through "H", your certificate will expire on **December 31, 2021.**

If your last name begins with "I" through "Q", your certificate will expire on **December 31, 2022.**

If your last name begins with "R" through "Z", your certificate will expire on **December 31, 2023.**
