RESOLUTION NO. 22-01M

RESOLUTION OF THE CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY HOUSING AGENCY APPROVING AND RATIFYING THE ADDITION OF PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS TO THE AGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Joint Exercise of Powers Act, comprising Articles 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Chapter 5 of Division 7 of Title 1 (commencing with Section 6500) of the Government Code of the State of California (the "Act"), Kings County and the Housing Authority of Kings County entered into a joint exercise of powers agreement (the "Agreement") pursuant to which the California Community Housing Agency (the "Agency") was organized;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 12 of the Agreement, the Agency may add a qualifying public agency to become a Non-Charter Member (an "Additional Member") upon the filing by such public agency with the Agency of a resolution of the governing body of such public agency requesting to be added as an Additional Member of the Agency and adoption of a resolution of the Board approving the addition of such public agency as an Additional Member;

WHEREAS, the Cities and/or Counties listed on Exhibit A hereto (the "City/County") have by resolution requested to join the Agency and the Agency has authorized each such City/County to become an Additional Member pursuant to the provisions of the Agreement;

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds and determines that each City/County is qualified to be added as an Additional Member to the Agency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the California Community Housing Agency, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. This Board hereby finds and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

<u>Section 2</u>. The addition of the Cities and/or Counties listed on Exhibit A hereto as Additional Members of the Agency is hereby approved, confirmed and ratified, and any actions heretofore taken on behalf of each City/County is hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.

<u>Section 3</u>. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

RESOLUTION OF DECLARATION OF OFFICIAL INTENT OF CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY HOUSING AGENCY TO ISSUE DEBT OBLIGATIONS TO UNDERTAKE THE FINANCING OF CERTAIN PROJECTS AND REIMBURSE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES FROM PROCEEDS OF SUCH DEBT OBLIGATIONS

WHEREAS, the California Community Housing Agency (the "Agency") intends to provide for the acquisition and ownership by the Agency of multifamily rental housing facilities in the City of Los Angeles identified in Exhibit A hereto (collectively, the "Projects"),

WHEREAS, the Agency expects to pay certain expenditures (the "Reimbursement Expenditures") in connection with the Project prior to the issuance of debt obligations for the purpose of financing costs associated with the Project on a long-term basis;

WHEREAS, the Agency wishes to declare its intention to authorize the issuance of debt obligations for the purpose of financing costs of the Projects (including reimbursement of the Reimbursement Expenditures) in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed the amount with respect to each Project set forth in Exhibit A hereto;

RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Agency, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Agency finds and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Agency hereby determines that it is necessary and desirable to provide financing for the Projects (including reimbursement of the Reimbursement Expenditures) by the issuance and sale of debt obligations, as shall be authorized by resolution of the Agency at a meeting to be held for such purpose, in aggregate principal amounts not to exceed the amounts set forth with respect to each Project in Exhibit A hereto. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to signify that the Projects comply with the planning, zoning, subdivision and building laws and ordinances applicable thereto or to suggest that the Agency or any member, officer or agent of the Agency will grant any such approval, consent or permit that may be required in connection with the Projects, or that the Agency will make any expenditures, incur any indebtedness, or proceed with the financing of the Projects.

SECTION 3. This declaration is made solely for purposes of establishing compliance with the requirements of Section 1.150-2 of the Treasury Regulations. This declaration does not bind the Agency to make any expenditure, incur any indebtedness, or proceed with the Projects.

SECTION 4. The Agency hereby declares its official intent to use proceeds of debt obligations to reimburse itself for Reimbursement Expenditures.

SECTION 5. This declaration shall take effect from and after its adoption.
