

Gentlemen:

In accordance with Section 65.5 of the Agricultural Code of the State of California, I herewith submit the 1965 Agricultural Crop Report of the County of Kings.

The total gross value of all products was more than two million dollars below that of 1964. Although there were several contributing factors, a reduction of thirteen hundred acres in total cotton acres harvested accounted for a value loss far greater than this. It is significant to note, while cotton suffered great losses, remarkable gains were made on both field corn and safflower values. The entire field crop category sustained a loss value of approximately three and one-half million dollars or slightly more than that of cotton lint. All other categories made steady gains except Livestock and Poultry where a drastic reduction was made in the number of feeder animals handled and length of time spent on feed.

It must be emphasized, the values quoted in this report are gross values. They can in no manner be construed to mean actual gains or losses to our farmers. Production, harvesting, packaging and marketing costs must be deducted to arrive at a net return.

To all the many individuals, agencies and organizations who contributed to this report I offer my sincere gratitude, to my staff, for the long hours spent in the gathering of statistics, I am also grateful, and give special acknowledgement to Clara Galletti for her part in the compilation of this report.
