SUBJECT: ASSESSMENT ROLL PRESENTATION

SUMMARY:

Overview:

The Assessor will present an overview of the assessed values for the county, the incorporated cities, and areas within the rural parts of Kings County. In addition, information will be given regarding the office workload, along with impacts resulting from inflation and the housing market.

Recommendation:

Accept the report on the Assessment Roll as continued from the July 18, 2022 meeting.

Fiscal Impact:

There are no known fiscal impacts related to this report.

BACKGROUND:

Revenue and Taxation Code Section 1604(a) (2) requires the County Board of Equalization to meet on the third Monday in July for the purpose of equalizing the assessment role. Since the implementation of Proposition 13 in the 1970s, the Board no longer equalizes the roll in total, so this time is utilized to report to the Board the status of the roll. For the current fiscal year, a 30-day extension to close the roll was requested by the Assessor and granted by the State Board of Equalization. The Assessor presented a status of the Assessment Roll on July 18, 2022 and the Board of Equalization continued the item. The Assessor submitted a letter on July 26, 2022 that the Local Assessment Roll for 2022-2023 was completed and worked with staff to determine a date for the Board of Equalization to hear the final report. The matter was set for August 16, 2022 at 8:30 a.m.
