NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 15626, 15628, 15629, and California Code of Regulation Section 20819, the public recount of the ballots cast in Kings County for the California Senate District #16 election at the request of candidate David Shepard will commence on:

## TUESDAY, DECEMBER 27, 2022, at 9:00 a.m.

The recount activities will commence on Tuesday, December 27, 2022, through Friday, December 30, 2022, and will resume operations on Tuesday, January 3, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. All recount activities will take place at the Kings County Elections Department, 1400 W. Lacey Blvd. Building #7, Hanford CA, 93230 and thereafter every day until completed or terminated.

The recount process will begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m. daily, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays excepted until completed or terminated. During staff breaks and lunch breaks, all individuals will leave the room and the room will be locked.

The daily schedule will be in accordance with Elections Code Section 15626 for not less than six hours each day, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays excepted, until the recount is completed. Conduct of this recount is subject to the receipt of necessary funds.
