Dear Mrs. Rahn,

I am writing this letter to oppose the title change of my current position from First 5 Program Officer to First 5 Program Manager, as well as the recommendation to keep my salary range at 236.5, while my peers, Behavioral Health (BH) Program Manager and Public Health (PH) Program Manager, are being recommended a salary range increase to 250.5.

The First 5 Program Officer is a unique title for First 5 programs and given that most First 5 agencies are independent organizations, it appears several inequitable positions were chosen to compare to my current position. One of the positions that was used for comparison is a Confidential Assistant, AKA Human Resources Specialist, whose education & experience requirements are 1 year of clerical experience and an associate's degree or 3 years of clerical experience. The position equivalent in Tulare County is the Chief Program Officer, not the Program Officer position. In Kings County, the First 5 Program Officer performs duties similar to those of a First 5 Executive Director, except for signature authority and the ability to enter into contracts under a certain amount.

I compared the BH and PH Program Manager to my current job description, and aside from those duties, I am also responsible for ensuring coordination of Commission meetings, preparation of agenda, minutes and other documents, gathering and preparing documentation for the annual Audit, reviewing and proposing updates to the Strategic Plan, developing and monitoring a Department budget (First 5 is its own department, not just program), and other First 5-specific duties.

Aside from my duties to the Commission, as a manager under Public Health, I am assisting with Public Health Accreditation, and have been asked to also take on new projects related to outside grants.

Should the decision remain that my title be changed to First 5 Program Manager, I respectfully request that it be recommended for my salary range be set at 250.5, and if that is not possible, I respectfully request a lateral promotion to Public Health Program Manager.

It should also be noted that the Commission contracts with the County for administrative functions, including Personnel, and the Commission should be able to weigh in on this change, and respond to the County of Kings' proposal to change the position title and the lack of change of the salary of the staff assigned to the Commission.

My name is Analy Martinez. I am submitting public comment in writing to the Board of Supervisors. I served as a Program Officer and Senior Program Officer for First 5 Kern from 2017-2023. I worked along side Clarissa Ravelo, F5 Kings Program Officer at the state, regional, and local level. In 2022 I had the privilege of being selected for the F5 Association Leaderhip Cohort along with Clarissa and a group of other folks representing First 5's across California.

In support of Clarissa's significant concerns, I am expressing opposition to the proposed recommendation of reclassification and staff title changes, specifically related to that of Program Officer for First 5 Kings County.

Through my experience as First 5 Program Officer and Senior Program Officer, I share with you that the First 5 Program Officer position is unique to the ecosystem of First 5. A Program Officer functions as a high level employee with a multitude of responsibilities such as program oversight, program management, integration of programs and systems of care. This includes a holistic understanding of contract management (e.g., fiscal, data, program, etc) and alignment. For example, during my role as Program Officer my responsibilities include programs at the state level, regional (multi-counties), and county-wide programs. Understanding the broader picture of how local F5 Commissions align with the F5CA and F5 Association Strategic Plans requires a level of engagement that is beyond the responsibilities of a County Program Manager. The Program Officer must be familiar with the Strategic Plans of the larger state system of First 5 California along with the local F5 Stratgic Plan and Kings County priorities. The role of a First 5 Program Officer is unique as they provide funding oversight, program guidance, and resources to local organizations that are implementing the work to narrow the gaps of services at the local level. Therefore, the Program Officer position requires a high level of understanding of the statewide purpose and the oversight of the public funds allocated to the local county.

Making a recommendation to lump the Program Officer position into a category with a pay scale that does not align with the level of responsibilities is inequitable. I invite you to reconsider and take a deep dive into the day to day responsibilities that are under the umbrella of the First 5 Kings County Program Officer role before making a decision. The significant Program Officer responsibilities include being accountable to and steering the First 5 Kings County Commission to best serve Children and Families.
