NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Kings County Board of Supervisors is seeking applications to fill vacancies on the Kings County Workforce Development Board and will consider making appointments to fill the vacancies at a regular meeting to be held anytime after September 2, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers at the Kings County Government Center, 1400 West Lacey Boulevard, Hanford, California.

KINGS COUNTY WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD

Six (6) vacancies currently exist on this Board for the following representatives: (1) Education & One Stop Job Center Partner, (1) Education – College of the Sequoias, (1) Organized Labor/SEIU Local 1000 and (3) Private Sector Business. All appointments are for three (3) years unless filling an unexpired term. The vacancies for this notice have terms expiring on June 30, 2026 (2), June 30, 2027 (3), and June 30, 2028 (1). Members are appointed by the Board of Supervisors are subject to the approval of the Governor of the State of California.

Criteria for appointment: Applicants must meet the specific representation of the position in which the vacancy exists. The Board consists of twenty-five (25) members comprised of the following: Private Sector Business representatives, Community Based Organizations representatives, Economic Development Agency representative, Education representatives (Secondary & Post-Secondary), Organized Labor representatives, and One-Stop Job Center Partners.

The Workforce Development Board (WDB) acts with equal authority with the Kings County Board of Supervisors in the setting of basic goals, policies, and procedures for programs under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act. The WDB exercises oversight responsibilities, recommends an administrative plan to the Board of Supervisors, and provides input regarding employment, training, and related services in the Workforce Development Area.

The purpose of this notice is to give any individual the opportunity to apply as well as any special interest group the opportunity to submit names of individuals to be considered for appointment.
