

Statement of Reasons for Recall

Mrs. Claudia Cazares has been negligent and ineffective in her duties as Board of Education member by failing to prioritize the education of our children. She has approved unjustified raises for administrators. By failing to review and question the superintendent's agenda, Mrs. Cazares has made misinformed decisions. She has consistently shown a lack of respect for the concerns of community members.
