# VIII 10:00 AM G. PUBLIC HEARING

### Community Development Agency- Greg Gatzka/Dan Kassik

Consider reviewing alternatives to the County's Land Conservation Act Program implementation and hold a Public Hearing to receive public testimony regarding implementation of Section 51244(b), which allows for the 10% reduction in Williamson Act and Farmland Security Zone Contract terms. If the Board adopts implementation of Section 51244(b) the following actions are also recommended:

- Determine that the State funded less than one-half of Kings County's actual forgone property tax revenues in the prior fiscal year (FY 2014/2015);
- State that landowners may choose to not participate in implementation of Section 51244(b) by serving a notice of non-renewal within 90 days of the date of notice of the opportunity to prevent the modification and reevaluation of contracts authorized by Section 51244(b) or before February 1, 2016;
- Amend the County's Land Conservation Act Program Procedures by extending the deadline for landowners to file notices of non-renewal for calendar year 2015 to February 1, 2016; and
- Adopt the attached resolution authorizing the County to implement Section 51244(b).
